iannet.org Software EULA

This iannet.org (iannet) End-User License Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between you ("you") and iannet for the software product ("Software") produced by iannet. By installing, copying, or otherwise using the Software, you agree to be bound by the terms of this EULA.
